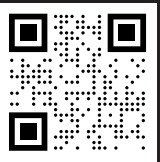


2024 GENERAL ELECTION GUIDE

VOTER FRAUD:

To prevent voter fraud, it’s best to vote in person at the Voter Registrars Office in Kearny Mesa or bring your ballot to an Awaken service.

PROPOSITIONS:

PROP 2: NO

This is a \$10 billion bond (a.k.a) tax to be used for school districts that will cost the taxpayers \$7.5 billion in interest over the next 35 years.

PROP 3: NO

Rewrites state Constitution changing the definition of marriage from “between a man and a woman” to “the right to marry is a fundamental right.”

PROP 4: NO

This is a \$10 billion bond (a.k.a) tax to be used for climate projects that will cost the taxpayers \$6 billion in interest over the next 40 years.

PROP 5: NO

This guts Prop 13 by making it easier for Sacramento to increase property taxes moving the vote to 55% instead of the required 66.67% to pass.

PROP 6: NO

Allows prisoners to unionize and removes the requirements to work.

PROP 32: NO

Makes state minimum wage \$18/hr. This would be detrimental to small business who are already struggling to survive in this economy. This would continue to drive up costs of everything.

PROP 33: NO

Would appeal a previous law that prevents local governments from passing rent controls.

PROP 34: YES

Prevents the AIDS Healthcare Foundation from spending taxpayer money to fund liberal ballot measures.

PROP 35: NO

This would make a temporary health care tax permanent.

PROP 36: YES

Reverses Prop 47 where criminals only get charged a misdemeanor for many theft and drug related crimes. This restores the police’s ability to arrest criminals and keep our communities safe.

LOCAL MEASURES:

MEASURE G: NO

Increases the county sales tax by a massive amount and doesn’t require politicians to spend the money on roads.

MEASURE A (DEL MAR): NO

This measure is a pay hike for the city council.

MEASURE B (CARLSBAD): NO

Limits voter approval rights for public facility projects built with taxpayer money.

MEASURE C (SAN DIEGO CITY): YES

Saves money by eliminating the primary election for school board races if there are 2 or fewer candidates.

MEASURE D (SAN DIEGO CITY): YES

Strengthens the Ethics Commission so it can control it’s own staffing and budget. They are the watchdog over politicians.

MEASURE E (SAN DIEGO CITY): NO

Increases City of San Diego sales taxes. NO new sales taxes!!

MEASURE H (POWAY): YES

Modifies a project already voted on by residents so it can be finished and benefit the community.

MEASURE I (ESCONDIDO): NO

Increases Escondido sales taxes.

MEASURE J (EL CAJON): NO

Increases El Cajon sales taxes.

MEASURE K (ENCINITAS): NO

Increases Encinitas sales taxes.

MEASURE L (LA MESA): NO

Increases La Mesa sales taxes.

MEASURE M (DEL MAR): NO

Redefines the hotel sales tax to include additional properties and transactions. NO new taxes!!
